



How to send us files
with FTP
through Netscape Navigator





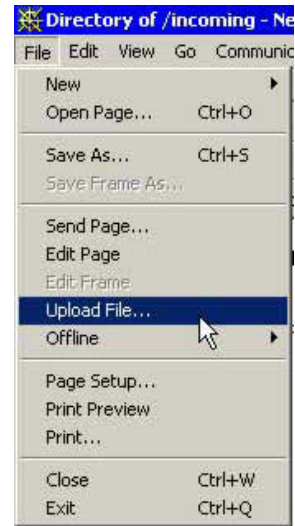
In the "Location" window, type in our ftp's URL: ftp://207.94.215.99

It may take a moment for the page to load, as our server logs you in as an anonymous user.

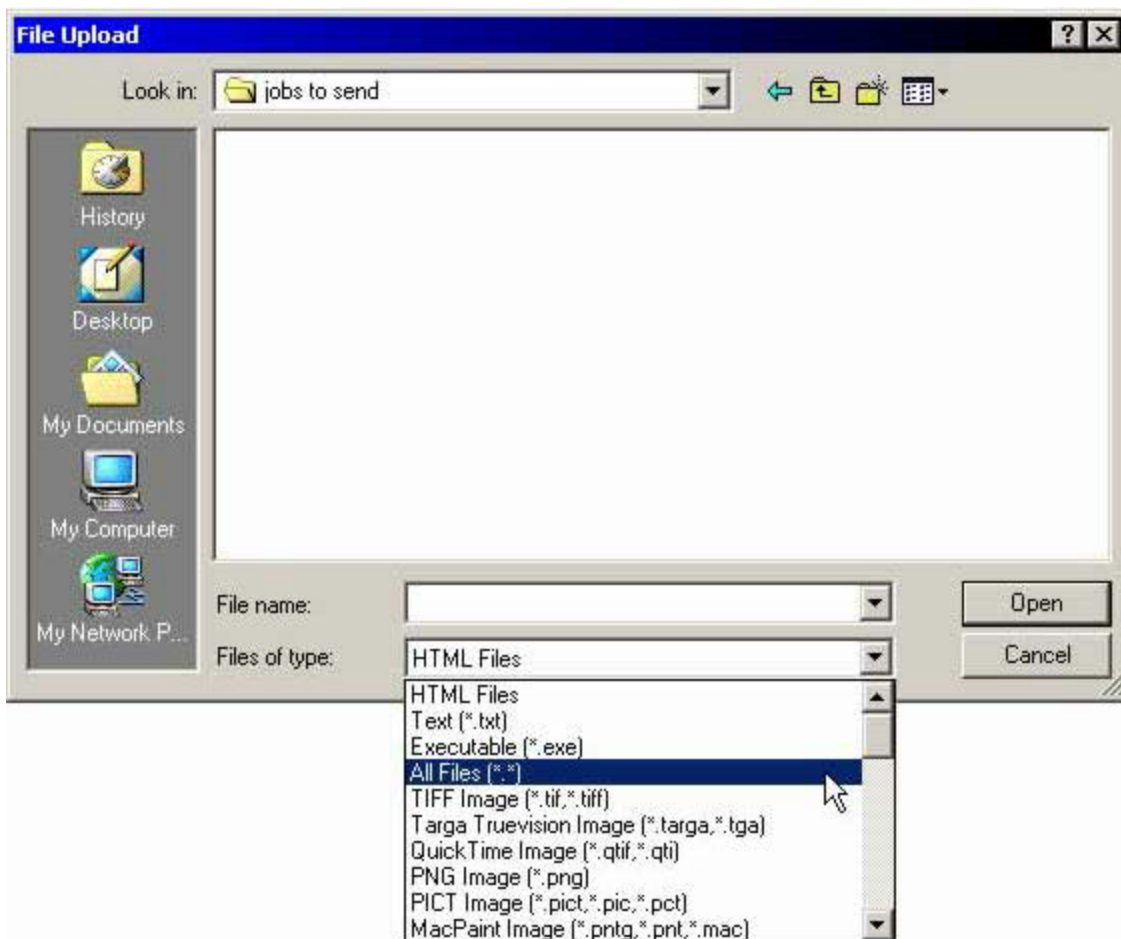
Click on the "incoming" folder. It is there that you will be uploading files.

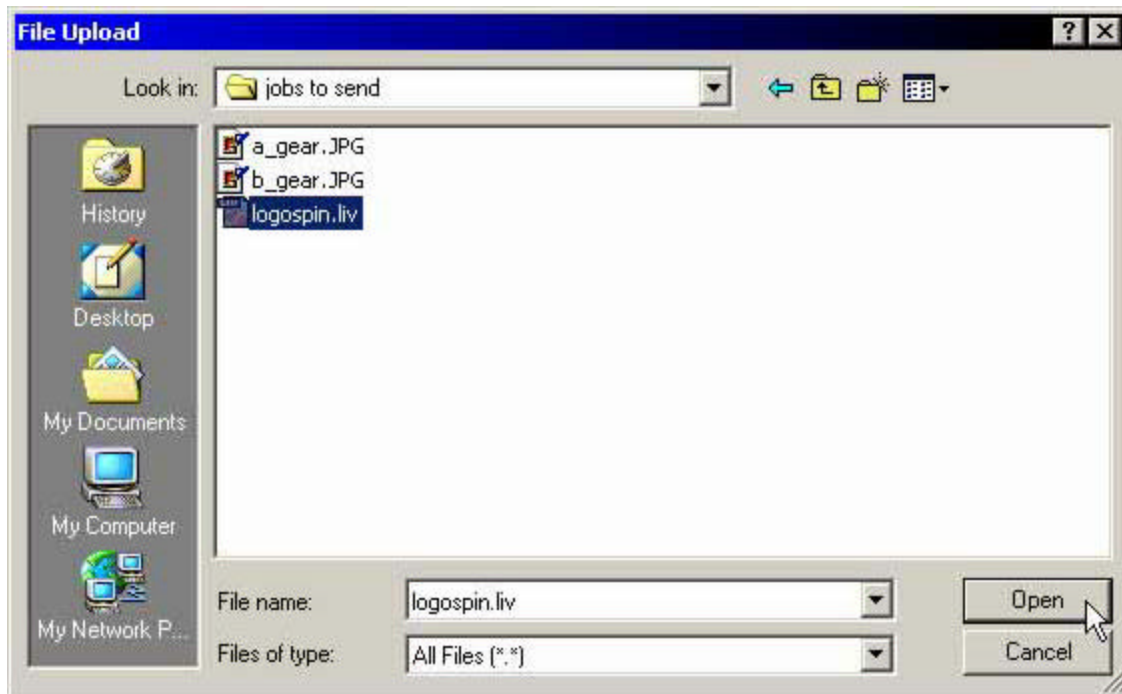
NOTE: When the incoming folder loads, it will appear empty. This is because anonymous ftp users can view only files that are uploaded during the current session. There is a quirk in Navigator that hides even those files, so the folder will always appear empty.

Click on the File menu and select “Upload File.”



The “File Upload” window opens and defaults to HTML files. Use the scroll menu to select “All Files.” (Or select the specific type of file you are uploading.)





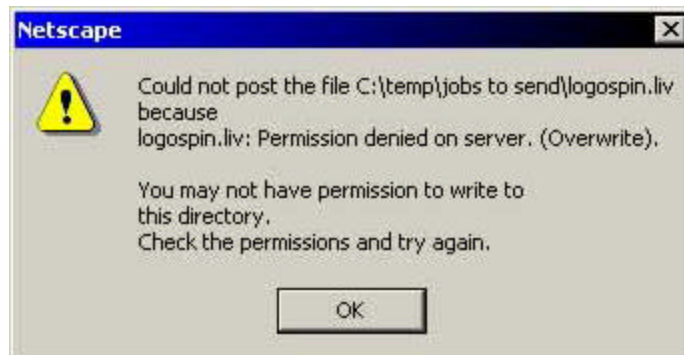
Select the file you want to upload. Click on “Open.”

NOTE: Navigator allows you to upload only one file at a time.

The following window displays while the file uploads. If the file is small, this window will flash by very quickly.



If our server is holding a file of the same name as the one you are trying to upload, this error will appear:



Simply rename the file you want to send, and then try again.

NOTE: Please keep in mind that the “incoming” directory will appear empty, even after you upload a file to it.
